



# Cancellation Policy

## Booking & Payment:

- A 40% deposit of the total expedition price is required to secure your reservation. (This applies to all Expeditions, Deep Camps, and Courses.)
- The remaining balance must be paid in full 14 days before the expedition start date.

## Cancellation by Client:

- Within 14 Days of Expedition: If you cancel your expedition within 14 days of the start date, the full amount paid (deposit and remaining balance) is non-refundable.
- 45 Days or Less Before Expedition: If you cancel your expedition 45 days or less before the start date, your deposit is non-refundable.
- 46 to 90 Days Before Expedition: If you cancel your expedition between 46 and 90 days before the start date, a 50% refund of your deposit will be issued.
- 91 or More Days Before Expedition: For cancellations made 91 or more days before the start date, a full refund will be provided.

## Cancellation by Freediving Explorations:

In the unlikely event that Freediving Explorations needs to cancel an expedition due to weather, unforeseen circumstances, or insufficient participant numbers, we will provide you with a full refund or offer you the opportunity to reschedule your expedition for a later date.

## Medical Emergencies:

- While we understand that unforeseen medical issues can arise, please be aware that the non-refundable deposit policy generally applies.
- If you must cancel your expedition due to a medical emergency, please provide appropriate documentation (e.g., doctor's note).
- We will work with you on a case-by-case basis to find a suitable solution, such as rescheduling or applying the deposit towards a future expedition.
- We strongly recommend purchasing travel insurance that specifically covers adventure activities, including freediving, to protect yourself from unexpected medical expenses and trip interruptions.

- This policy applies to all Freediving Explorations expeditions, including Deep Camps, and Courses.
